ABOUT

Made from fruit grown from various Greenstone Point vineyards in the heart of Waipara Valley, North Canterbury. The vineyards have a variety of soil structures and climate conditions. The resulting fruit has subtle differences in the flavour profiles and provide a wide range of blending potential in the finished wine. The 2018 harvest started early in mid-March with warm, dry conditions leading to a rapid ripening of the fruit. The harvested fruit was subject to a cool soak in open top fermenters before yeast was added to initiate ferment. The cap was hand plunged daily before the wine was pressed off skins and underwent oak maturation. The wine was then blended prior to filtering and bottling.

Abundant fruit aromas. Ripe blackberry fruit flavours balanced by subtle tannins and smooth mouthfeel. An easy to drink wine. Best enjoyed in the company of friends or with Pork or Mediterranean dishes.
