ABOUT

Produced from Pinot Noir grapes grown on the Pilgrim, Glasnevin, Terraces, Georges Rd, Stirling and Church Road vineyards in the Waipara Valley, North Canterbury. After 2 days of skin contact the lightly coloured Pinot Noir juice was racked off the skins and put through a cool fermentation. The selected parcels were then blended and aged on lees for a further 7 months. The wine was then lightly fined, filtered and bottled.

TASTING NOTES

Concentrated fruit flavours and lifted acidity make this a refreshing wine. The subtle fruit sweetness adds a creaminess to the palate and a smooth mouthfeel. The richness of flavour make this perfect to enjoy all year round.
